- Review and professional sign off for Phase 1 ESA Reports
- Preparation of Site-Specific Liability and Acquisition Assessments
- Preparation and review of Phase 2 ESA scopes of work and Remedial Action and Risk Management Plans
- Project Management for Tier 2 and Subsoil Salinity Tool assessments including review of background information, development of scope of work and sampling plan, supervision of field activities, budget and cost tracking, and review and interpretation of results.
- Supervise and mentor junior staff within the Environmental Assessment and Remediation team in technical reporting and field activities
- Participate in field activities for all Environmental Assessment and Remediation projects on an as-needed basis
